As part of our reading list, last month's book was "The Lamb's Supper: The Mass as Heaven on Earth". This is continuing our theme on the Eucharist. "The Lamb's Supper reveals a long-lost secret of the Church: The early Christians' key to understanding the mysteries of the Mass was the New Testament Book of Revelation. With its bizarre imagery, its mystic visions of heaven, and its end-of-time prophecies, Revelation mirrors the sacrifice and celebration of the Eucharist."

Book 4 will be announced at the next meeting.

The Eucharist continues to be a central theme, in our Faith in Action Program, The Archdiocese Beacons of Light, and the Eucharistic Revival. Continue to make it the central part of your lives.

### Council 14504 Minutes for October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022

### Call to Order:

The meeting was held in person. The Grand Knight, John Hoffman, called the Council to order at 7:30 pm and led the Opening Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

### **Approval of Meeting Minutes**

Mike Nowak previously e-mailed the Council meeting minutes from September 13, 2022, to all members via Council newsletter. After motions by Sean Gammon and Danny Sprouse, the Council approved the minutes as published.

### Chaplain's Message:

Nothing reported.

### Grand Knight's Report:

The Grand Knight encouraged all to read, "The Lamb's Supper - The Mass as Heaven on Earth", by author Scott Hahn. This is in light of the fact that only about 31% of Catholics believe that Christ is present in the Blessed Sacrament.

The Grand Knights also encouraged attendance at Eucharistic Adoration and advised that a Memorial Mass will be scheduled for after the November meeting.

### **Financial Report:**

The Treasurer, Mike Nowak, reported that there were deposits totaling \$2251.36 and expenses of 1018.39. The checking balance is now at 3630.75. The savings balance is \$19,535.22.

### **Membership Report:**

State Membership Director Michael Freil reported that the council needs to recruit 6 or 7 candidates in order to meet goal. All were asked to invite a man to join the Order. Michael advised that a membership blitz should be scheduled for the remaining weekends of October.

### **Program Reports:**

Community Report – Steve Berns reported that the council, members and relatives donated at total of \$910 to the 2022 Walk to End Alzheimer's.

Mike Manzo reported that around \$913 was made from the spaghetti dinner. He also reported that the Men's Club fish fry is scheduled for November 18<sup>th</sup> and that worker signup sheets will be provided in the Gathering Space.

Michael Freil advised that he will schedule a Highway Cleanup on an upcoming Saturday, before the weather becomes too cold.

### **Report of the Fourth Degree**

Michael Friel reported that a in-person 4<sup>th</sup> Degree exemplification is scheduled for November 19<sup>th</sup> at St Francis of Assisi church. He advised that there have been efforts to open the Exemplification to all, but it is still open to only 4<sup>th</sup> degree members and candidates. Turn in Matching Funds donations. ### **Field Agent Report**

Field Agent was not present.

### **District Deputy Report**

District Deputy, Ken Haacke, reported that there will be a \$40 incentive to recruit a new member and that the code for free membership is Blessed McGivney. He advised that the turn-in of Football Crazr tickets is due by November 1. It was noted that Food For Family activities associated with Thanksgiving should be recorded.

Ken advised that a Rosary Rally is scheduled for 2 PM on October 23<sup>rd</sup> at Immaculate Conception.

Ken encouraged all Knights to attend the movie "Mother Teresa: No Greater Love" which will be in theaters on November 2 and 3.

Ken reminded all that a Christmas celebration is scheduled for 5 PM on December 11<sup>th</sup> at the Station House, located on the St. Leonard grounds. Tickets will be \$20 per person at the door.

### **Unfinished Business:**

The proposed Resolution 1, which was previously tabled, was noted as unfinished business. (See below)

### **New Business:**

The proposed Resolution 1, which was previously tabled, was voted upon and passed. Danny Sprouse and Ken Haacke presented the motions. Article 1, Section 4 will now read: "The Financial Secretary shall receive annual compensation, payable in quarterly installments at the end of each quarter, from the council an amount equal to 8% of the moneys collected on account of dues from insurance and associate members. The Financial Secretary, at his discretion, may forgo his compensation or have such funds directed to one of the charities supported by the council."

The Financial Secretary advised that Matching Funds will be due by November 15. Cal Frank motioned to donate \$200. Danny Sprouse seconded and the motion passed.

Cal Frank requested that a member assist with the mulch sale activity, which will begin in January. He advised that the funds raised from the sale should allow the council to support 5 seminarians.

Mike Manzo indicated that the next Spaghetti Dinner will be on April 15<sup>th</sup>.

Steve Berns motioned for the council to purchase two containers of coats for boys and girls in youth sizes from the Supreme supply site. The cost listed by Supreme is \$237.38 for each set of 12 coats. Danny Sprouse seconded and the motion passed.


