Council 14504 Minutes for January 10th, 2023

Call to Order:

The meeting was held in person. The Grand Knight, John Hoffman, called the Council to order at 7:30 pm and led the Opening Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Mike Nowak previously e-mailed the Council meeting minutes from December 13th, 2022, to all members via Council newsletter. After motions the Council approved the minutes.

Chaplain's Message

Nothing reported.

Grand Knight's Report

The Grand Knight, John Hoffman, encouraged all to read, "The Creed: Professing the Faith through the Ages, by author Scott Hahn. He also encouraged participation in the National Eucharistic Revival which invites all to renew love for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament by providing a "grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist." The Grand Knight reported on the St. Francis Men's Retreat, scheduled January 20-22nd, at the Bergamo Center, and the National Men's Conference, scheduled March 25th, in Cincinnati.

Financial Report

The Treasurer, Mike Nowak, reported on deposits and expenses. The Council's checking and savings accounts balances total \$17,598.50.

Membership Report

Mr. Kerry Taylor (newly reactivated member) and Mr. Chuck Ormsby (transfer from St Mary of the Assumption parish) were nominated for Council membership. After motions, the Council approved both for full membership into the Council.

State Membership Director, Michael Freil, reported on the current statewide membership results. He asked all Knights to invite a man to join the Order, and to use the E-Member process.

Program Reports

Cal Frank requested assistance at the upcoming Donut Sunday, scheduled January 15th.

Cal Frank also requested assistance in preparing for the Council's annual mulch sale scheduled early this Spring. This sale is the Council's largest source of funds and allows the Council to support five seminarians.

Danny Sprouse recommended Knights donate to the 2023 Catholic Ministry Appeal for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

Michael Friel discussed the movie, "Mother Teresa: No Greater Love". The Council discussed how and when to show this inspirational movie to the Parish. This issue was tabled with more discussion to follow.

The Financial Secretary, Bob Luppino, reported on the status of membership dues, and that the KofC Spiritual Planner books were available for \$5/book.

Michael Friel reported the next 4th Degree Cardinal Joseph Bernardin Assembly 3056 monthly meeting is scheduled on Tuesday, January 24th (7:00 pm Rosary followed by 7:30 pm business meeting).

Field Agent Report

The Field Agent was not present.

District Deputy Report

District Deputy, Ken Haacke, reported the following:

- 1. Supreme Council has started the Affiliate Program. This program allows Councils to remove non-active members from their rosters without penalty.
- 2. The Council's "Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity" (Form 1728) is due by January 31st, 2023, and the "Semi-annual Council Audit" (Form 1295) is due by February 15th.
- 3. Councils will receive \$35 bonus for every new member.
- 4. Super Cash Bonanza meeting is scheduled Saturday, February 4th at St Paul Church in Englewood at 3:00pm. Super Cash Bonanza is the Ohio State Council's annual charity campaign; income generated by ticket sales provides funding the Church, school systems, and community projects.
