Council 14504 Minutes for April 11th, 2023

Call to Order:

The Council held the meeting in person. The Grand Knight, John Hoffman, called the Council to order at 7:30 pm and led the Opening Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Mike Nowak previously e-mailed the Council meeting minutes from March 14th, 2023, to all members via Council newsletter. After motions by Danny Sprouse and Mike Manzo, the Council approved the minutes as published.

Chaplain's Message:

Nothing reported.

Grand Knight's Report:

The Grand Knight reported the next KofC Dayton Dragon's game is scheduled June 10, 2023.

The Grand Knight requested volunteers to assist with the sale/delivery of mulch, scheduled this Saturday, April 15th from 8:30 am - 2:30 pm, and with the Council's Spaghetti Dinner, scheduled Saturday, April 15th from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm. The Council's "Donut Sunday" is also this weekend on Sunday, April 16th.

The Grand Knight presented a \$500 check to Tom Kwest for the parish's St. Vincent DePaul efforts.

The Grand Knight discussed the nomination of officers (officer slate) for the 2023-2024 year; elections will be at the next Council meeting scheduled for May 9th.

The Grand Knight encouraged all to read, "A Father Who Keeps His Promises" by author Scott Hahn.

Financial Report:

The Treasurer, Mike Nowak, reported deposits, expenses, and account balances. Financial Secretary, Bob Luppino, reported that to date 15 members have yet to pay their annual Council dues and will send each their third late letter.

Membership Report:

State Membership Director Michael Freil reported that the Council needs six new members to meet its annual goal. He also made a motion to readmit James Stephenson into the Council. Joe Schmidt seconded the motion, and the Council approved the motion.

Program Reports:

Mike Manzo reported the Parish Fish Fry on March 24th was a huge success, making approximately \$10,000. He also reported the next Euchre Party is scheduled May 20th. He reminded all Knights that rosaries are prayed every the third, fourth, and fifth Wednesday of the month (in the church main chapel).

Michael Tortorici discussed making a Council initiative to sponsor a religious-based trip to Fatima, Lourdes, and Barcelona (approximately 10 days, dates to be determined). He will work on initial details with a known reputable travel agency; more information and discussion to follow in future meetings.

Cal Frank discussed final preparations for the Council mulch sale; he also reported the next official US Flag retirement is scheduled June 12th near the church picnic area.

Report of the Fourth Degree

Michael Friel reported approximately 28 Knights received the Fourth Degree at the recent Exemplification on March 26th in Loveland, Ohio.

Field Agent Report

Field Agent, Brien Hartung, was not present.

District Deputy Report

Danny Sprouse reported that Council program reports are due May 15th.

Unfinished Business:

Danny Sprouse made a motion, seconded by Shawn McManamy, to un-table last month's motion to purchase rosaries for approximately \$1,300 which will be distributed to the Parish. The Council approved the motion.

Joe Schmidt made a motion, seconded by Steve Berns, to un-table last month's motion to donate \$1000 to the Bishop Fenwick Society, which supports the mission of The Athenaeum of Ohio/Mount St. Mary's Seminary. The Council approved the motion.

New Business:

Danny Sprouse made a motion, seconded by Steve Berns, to donate \$500 to the "Support Our Seminarians" campaign, which supports seminarians and promotes vocations. The Council approved the motion.

Mike Manzo made a motion to donate up to \$150 of snacks during the Council's upcoming presentation(s) of the movie, "Mother Teresa: No Greater Love". This was seconded by Chuck Martinson, and subsequently approved by the Council.
