## Council 14504 Minutes for September 10th, 2024

#### **Call to Order:**

The meeting was held in person and called to Order by Grand Knight (GK) Sean Gammons at 7:30 PM. GK led the Council in an opening prayer and the pledge of allegiance.

#### **Approval of Meeting Minutes:**

Council meeting minutes from August 13, 2024, were approved after a motion to approve was passed and voted on by Council.

#### **Chaplain's Message:**

Nothing reported.

#### **Grand Knight's Report:**

GK Gammons reported on preparations for the upcoming Parish movie night hosted by the Council. Discussion was held regarding advertising this family event and having adequate food and refreshments. GK announced the movie to be shown will be "Cabrini."

Recruitment weekend will be after all masses the weekend of September 28-29, members are asked to give a few minutes to help staff the table and answer questions from prospective members. As always, GK urges all members to make everyday a recruitment opportunity.

#### **Financial Report:**

Council Treasurer Joe Schmidt reported deposits totaling \$7,043.79 and expenses of \$1,673.23. Checking account balance stands at \$14,341.22; savings account balance of \$15,537.91 (\$10,000 in a CD), for a total of \$29,879.13.

#### **Membership Report:**

Nothing to report.

#### **Program Report:**

Michael Friel reported on upcoming 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Exemplification taking place on September 28<sup>th</sup>. He provided some information on this degree as being the Patriotic Degree and the wonderful information one can learn about the subject going through this Degree formation.

He further noted that after January 2025, the Exemplification Ceremony will be opened to the Knight's family to attend and share in the moment.

On September 14<sup>th</sup>, The Council will participate in the service project of the IR-675 interchange at Wilmington Pike. Friel asked all Knights who can meet at the Parish to be provided with safety equipment and further information.

Mike Manzo provided information about the recent Parish picnic. He reported over 1,500 people were served food comprised of about seven hundred hamburgers, four hundred hot dogs and four hundred brats.

October 5<sup>th</sup> will be the Council's spaghetti dinner and help will be needed. He stated information will be coming as to times and jobs which need to be filled.

A request was made from the parish Respect Life ministry for food prep assistance for their dinner on October 17<sup>th</sup>, four volunteers are requested.

#### **Unfinished Business:**

The recorder reported only unfinished business was discussion from last Council meeting regarding establishing a gift of money for all retired priests who serve the Parish. As members who are part of this discussion were not present, the item was shelved until the October meeting.

#### **New Business:**

A motion was made requesting money to purchase commemorative Rosaries to be given to the family after the passing of a Knight. Michael Friel explained the cost of each is about \$30 each and he requested the amount of \$225 to begin the program. The motion was seconded by Bob Whitman and after Council vote was passed.

GK Gammons requested funding for refreshments to be served at the upcoming Council movie night. After discussion, Michael Friel motioned to provide \$300 for the event which was seconded by Steve Berns. After Council vote, the motion was passed.

A motion was made and passed to provide \$200 towards expenses for the Respect Life dinner in November.

Danny Sprouse made motion to give a \$100 donation to Father Joseph which would be passed on to Father's school in India. The motion was seconded and passed after vote of Council.
