Council 14504 Minutes for December 10th, 2024

Call to Order:

The meeting was held in person. Grand Knight (GK) Sean Gammons called the Council to Order at 7:30 PM after leading the opening prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of meeting minutes:

A motion to approve the minutes from the November 2024 meeting was made by Danny Sprouse and seconded by Mike Tortorici, upon vote of Council they were approved.

Chaplain's Message:

Grand Knight's Report:

GK Gammons began his report by welcoming Jeremy McCoy and Nicholas Sylvian who completed their 3rd Degree ceremony prior to tonight's Council Meeting.

Friendship Sunday has been rescheduled from this month until January.

Financial Report:

Council Treasurer Joe Schmidt provided a report on the financial status of The Council. He reported total deposits of \$983.35; expenses of \$3,267.08; a checking balance of \$10,120.72; savings account balance of \$15,752.44 for a total of \$25,873.16. He provided details of each deposit and expense in his report.

Membership Report:

Michael Friel reported that with the addition of the two latest Knights, our annual membership drive is halfway completed. He urged Knights in attendance to continue asking and seeking new men to join.

Program Reports:

Mike Tortorici reported discussions are in the early stage regarding another pilgrimage trip in 2026.

District Deputy Report:

District Deputy John Brown provided an update on our Council's progress towards the Star Council award.

John Hoffman reported from the state office of the upcoming rollout of the Core Project to begin in 2025.

Financial Secretary Report:

Financial Secretary Mike Nowak reported that he will be mailing out registration information for fraternal year 2025. He asked that these, along with dues, be returned promptly to prevent reminders having to be mailed out. He also asked that Knights take the time to complete the attached survey of all service work done by members either as part of The Council or anything done for The Parish, like Eucharistic Ministry, helping with St. Vincent's etc. These hours logged are needed for documentation towards Council recognition.

Old Business:

Recorder Jim Stephenson advised the GK of the discussion for the monetary gift(s) to be made to those priests who assist activities at The Parish. John Hoffman clarified from earlier discussions the gift would be in the amount of \$350 per priest and would be financed by the money returned by the travel agency used in this past year's pilgrimage trip. After discussion and motions, The Council approved the item.

New Business:

A motion to donate \$100 to two parishioners heading up a medical missionary trip to Malawi was made by Jim Stephenson. The trip was described to members and a second to the motion was made by Mike Tortorici, the motion was passed upon vote.

Joe Schmidt reminded The Council of the upcoming Parish men's retreat being held in January of 2025.

Cal Frank requested the name(s) of the new sponsored seminarians be announced. He also noted he has Council shirts in all sizes for sale.

Danny Sprouse spoke to the members about the need for assistance for people to serve during The Mass as eucharistic ministers, sacristans and as servers during Mass. He asked that members think of Parish youth who could be serving as well as adult help with weekday Mass and funerals.

Lecturer's Report:

Lecturer Don Hirst provided an informative talk on the origins of the sign of the cross and the symbolism it represents.
