

Down to our council meeting business coming up on Feb. 10th. We will planning a couple things this spring. April 26th will be our annual mulch sale. Outside of dues, this considers over half of our non-charity revenue (revenue we do not collect specifically for charities).

Speaking of financials, we are still in a very healthy spot. We are able to provide for our parish community as well as outside. With this, we got to this point with sound fundraising, smart financial moves, and budgeting. Starting this month going into March, the officers' of this council and I will formulate a new budget for the 2025-2026 year. We will be presenting to the Council at the April meeting, with a final vote in May.

Speaking of financials, as GK, alongside Joe (Treasurer) and Deo the Deputy Grand Knight, we are switching from Fifth Third Bank to Wright Patt Credit Union. At the last council meeting, I relayed to everyone that this is a good financial move as Fifth Third is a national bank not reaching down to us as a bank. Wright Patt is a local credit union that will have a more personable touch. Plus as many of you know, Fifth Third was only giving a total of thirteen to fourteen cents in interest a month on our money with them. As always, any questions about financials, please reach out to Joe, Mike Nowak, or myself. We want to be as transparent as possible.

Coming at the next council meeting, we will have the Super Cash Bonanza tickets being handed out. These tickets help the State Council run charities plus the proceeds for us go help us fund our charities. Each envelope will have 5 tickets. Please consider buying some and if you need more, please reach out to me or Mike Nowak. We will be mailing the rest of to all those that cannot make the February Business Meeting.

If you need a council T-Shirt, please see Cal Frank after each mass. We will also have refreshments after each council business meeting. for fellowship and brotherhood.

Lastly, elections will be held in the May Business Meeting. Please send any nominations to me if you want to run for a specific position.

Council 14504 Minutes for January 14th, 2025

Call to Order:

The meeting was held in person. The Grand Knight, (GK), Sean Gammons called The Council to order at 7:30 PM and led the opening prayer and pledge of allegiance.

Approval of Meeting Minutes:

Council meeting minutes from the December 2024 meeting were approved after a motion was passed and voted upon by the Council members present.

Chaplain's Message:

Nothing to report.

Grand Knight's Report:

GK Gammons reported on preliminary information about the annual Council Mulch sale. A new vendor is being used, and details are being worked out on the cost and volume of mulch to purchase. The tentative date of the delivery will be April 27th.

The annual Easter hunt will be held after 11:00 Easter Mass. The eggs will be filled with candy after the April Council meeting and GK urged Knights to stay after that meeting to help.

Financial Report:

Treasurer Joe Schmidt was absent from this meeting due to illness but transmitted his report via email to Council Officers.

The report reflects deposits of \$467.89; expenses of \$3,257.67; checking account balance of \$10,120.72; savings account balance of \$15,752.44 for a total balance of \$25,873.16.

Council Financial Secretary Mike Nowak reminded members of their fraternal year 2025 dues, and he passed along several thank you cards from the parish family priests for their Christmas gifts.

Membership Report:

Michael Friel reported no new applications have been received. GK Gammons reported on a new member via an external transfer who would be voted on during the new business portion of the meeting.

Michael Friel notified the Council of the passing of John Monnett after a lengthy illness, he provided information about the upcoming visitation and funeral.

Mike Manzo reported that the spaghetti dinner will be scheduled for February 22 after consulting with the Parish activity calendar.

A new mulch vendor has been located and is currently looking at a price reduction from previous years and again selecting brown as the mulch color.

Manzo also reported that future fish fry events are on hold pending work being performed on the kitchen, he stated he could provide additional information to members after the business meeting.

Mike Tortorici provided an update on the planning of a Parish sponsored pilgrimage in 2026.

Mike Manzo reminded the Council of the Rosary led by Council on Wednesday nights and sought assistance from members to assist in leading.
